Summary and Action Items

- Cats on the Go for Faculty: Dr. Susan Day discussed with the Council that a service for students with temporary disabilities that impair mobility, transportation between locations, or classes on campus was available for students. She asked if this was a service that could also be available for faculty. Dr. Cynthia Opheim will explore the possibility of extending this service to faculty.
- PPS 7.22: Faculty Responsibilities, Definitions, and Titles: Proposed changes to PPS 7.22 were discussed. Significant changes and additions include the definition of “term condition” and the change in the term condition for Senior Lecturers from up to three to up to five years. These proposed changes will be circulated for comments.
- Demonstration of the New Catalog: A demonstration of the new undergraduate and graduate catalogs was presented to the Council. This new catalogs will go live on May 1, 2015.
- UPPS 07.07.06: Salaried Graduate Assistant Employment Revisions: Dr. Andrea Golato reviewed the substantive changes to UPPS 07.07.06 that were required by federal regulations and the affordable health care act: new assistantship types, allowable percentage appointments, and duties of assistants. All of these changes had been discussed at previous CAD meetings. The draft of the UPPS will be sent out for review.
- Undergraduate Admissions Report: Dr. Michael Heintze provided the Council with the undergraduate admissions report.
- Graduate Admissions Report: Dr. Andrea Golato provided the Council with the graduate admissions report.
