

Texas State University College of Science and Engineering Outstanding Graduate Student Award

Form A: Criteria for Nominating

The **Outstanding Graduate Student** for the College of Science and Engineering shall be determined on the basis of work done while in Graduate College at Texas State University, San Marcos. (This is meant to set limits for the time, but not the location of the work.) December candidates are eligible.

In determining the recipient, scholarship, research, teaching, and service shall be considered. In each of these categories, evidence to be weighed may include (but not be limited to):

Scholarship: G.P.A., GRE scores, expository seminars and presentations

Research: Thesis, grants, presentations, articles, laboratory or professional activities

Teaching: Teaching, excellence in lecturing, lab instruction or group instruction

Service: Club leadership, advising, hosting conferences

The following forms should be completed and forwarded to the department Chair by February 1, 2017 in a sealed envelope marked "Confidential—Graduate Award":

1. Nomination Form "B" (see website)
2. Letters of support (no more than three)
