

WRITING MINOR

Department of English – Texas State University

The minor in Writing requires 24 hours of coursework. Students may choose an emphasis in professional writing or in creative writing, or take course in both types of writing. Students majoring in English may not minor in Writing. Requirements for the minor are as follows:

Two first-year English courses

ENG 1310 – College Writing I

ENG 1320 – College Writing II

One sophomore literature course

ENG 2310, 2320, 2330, 2340, 2359, *or* 2360

One course in Practices in Writing and Rhetoric

ENG 3311 (Topic varies every semester)

Three of the following courses:

ENG 3303 – Technical Writing

ENG 3304 – Professional Writing

ENG 3315 – Introduction to Creative Writing

ENG 3342 – Editing

ENG 3348 – Creative Writing: Fiction (Prerequisite: ENG 3315)

ENG 3349 – Creative Writing: Poetry (Prerequisite: ENG 3315)

ENG 4348 – Senior Seminar in Fiction Writing (Prerequisite: ENG 3348)

ENG 4349 – Senior Seminar in Poetry Writing (Prerequisite: ENG 3349)

One advanced literature elective (writing intensive.) This includes any course from Group A (British Literature), Group B (American Literature), or Group C (World Literature.)
