The Washington Center has new internship opportunities through the **Federal Diversity Internship Initiative** - a fully funded, paid internship program with various federal agencies.

There is **high demand for students with a communications background** - such as journalism, mass communications, and public relations - during the upcoming summer semester. We expect students with related training and experience to be very successful candidates, and they are highly encouraged to apply!

Accepted students will have a chance to intern for **10 weeks** at one of these agencies:

- Federal Aviation Administration
- Consumer Financial Protection Bureau
- Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
- U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
- U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs

- U.S. Department of the Treasury
- U.S. Census Bureau
- National Archives and Records Administration

Interns will receive **housing** (paid for by The Washington Center) close to their internship location, a twice-monthly **stipend**, and professional guidance from a TWC adviser.

Interested students must submit an application by **January 18, 2017** to be considered.
