

EVENT INTERN

Description: The Event Intern is a part-time position open to current students. The Event Intern will be responsible for assisting with the production and execution of various assignments from company communications to client projects and events. This may include writing draft press releases, internet research, web stories and promotion, event planning and promotion, and other public relations, marketing, and communications. Examples of events you may help produce include non-profit 5Ks, benefit galas, Keep Austin Weird Festival, ThunderCloud Subs Turkey Trot, and many more.

Requirements: A self-starter who is ready to contribute to the event production of an active, dynamic and growing company. Current students enrolled or able to enroll in the internship course. Some weekend availability, successfully completed coursework in communications or public relations and/or experience with Adobe PhotoShop/Illustrator/InDesign and/or Microsoft Project are preferred, but not required.

MARKETING-COMMUNICATIONS INTERN

Some weekend availability, successfully completed coursework in communications or public relations and/or experience with social media platforms such as Facebook, Twitter, Foursquare, Gowalla, Youtube and Hootsuite is preferred, but not required.
