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**Requirements and General Information:**

Scholarships are intended to financially assist and reward incoming and current students pursuing a major in the Department of Agriculture. New student applicants (freshmen and transfers) must have submitted their application for admission to Texas State prior to applying for scholarships. In order to receive a scholarship, students must enroll as a full-time student (12 semester hours), and enroll in at least one agriculture class each semester. Scholarships will be awarded in various amounts for the upcoming academic year. Students will receive funds on a semester basis in a check issued after the 12th class day. Recipients should be prepared to make an installment on or pay in full their tuition (at the first installment deadline) prior to the receipt of a scholarship check issued after the 12th class day. In order to receive the second half of their scholarship in the spring, students must maintain the following guidelines:

1. Pass the minimum twelve (12) semester hours required in a specific agriculture major degree plan during the fall semester.
2. Maintain an overall GPA of 2.75 and make a minimum GPA of 2.75 each semester.
3. Enroll in at least one Agriculture course each semester.
4. Enroll in a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours for the spring semester in a specific agriculture major degree plan during advance registration.

**Most scholarships are awarded on a yearly basis. In order to be considered for scholarships each year, students must reapply for scholarships each December.**

**Application Checklist:**

- High School Students: attach a copy of your high school transcript & submit application for admission.
- Transfer students: attach an official copy of your transcript showing all course work & submit application for admission.
- Current Students: attach a working copy of your transcript from CATSWEB.
- Feel free to include any supporting documents (letters of recommendation, resume, etc.) that you feel will support your scholarship application.
- Sign the completed application and return it to the Department of Agriculture Scholarship Coordinator by the **January 15th** deadline.
