Description: Synchronic Spanish Linguistics

In this course we will examine the principal aspects of the structure of modern Spanish, including its sound system, word formation and relations, the organization of sentences, the interpretation of language in context, and how Spanish relates to other languages. Students will learn to examine language in a systematic way different from how they have probably approached it in the past. In doing so, they will achieve a greater understanding of the inner workings of Spanish and its place in a broader linguistic context. Students will read the required text and select additional readings.
