The Girls Empowerment Network (GEN) is a non-profit agency that provides social-emotional programming focused on building positive body image, healthy relationships and communication skills for girls in grades 3-12. Our mission is to support and guide girls to make wise choices as they navigate the unique pressures of girlhood.

Internship Opportunities

- Communications—contribute to social media, the agency blog/website, and external communications.
- Fundraising—assist with projects necessary to sustain programs for girls and gain valuable skills in a nonprofit Development Department.
- Project Management—help plan our annual conference, as well as contribute to marketing/PR efforts and initiatives for our camps, Pathfinder program, and special projects.
- Community Relations—serve as a representative of GEN in the community, table at outreach events, and assist with the recruitment, screening, and training of agency volunteers.
- Direct Service—contribute to curriculum review and revision, provide support on-site with programming, and facilitate groups at elementary, middle, and high schools.

The Girls Empowerment Network (GEN) is seeking strong leaders with a passion for girls' issues to fill a number of unpaid internships within our agency. All interns must be committed to the mission of GEN, be team-oriented, possess excellent verbal and written communication skills, and have reliable transportation. Internships typically last one semester (fall, spring or summer) and are anywhere from 10-40 hours/week.

Internship Application Procedures

Applicants are interviewed and selected on a rolling basis. Placements are typically filled by these dates: Fall – August 31 | Spring – December 7.
