DISMISSAL NOTICE

TO: Boyd-Shelvin Executive Alliance Clegg-Duncan Executive Alliance

FROM: Adrian Cooper SUB: Election Process Violation (EB 3/1.2017)

DATE: January 24, 2017

The Election Board received a claim that the Clegg-Duncan executive alliance has violated election rules established in the Student Government Election Code. The specific complaint is as follows:

On the afternoon of Tuesday, January 24, 2017 the Clegg-Colton Executive Alliance violated “Article 2.2 of the Election Code” as established in the Student Government Constitution by “posting an invite on Facebook for a ‘Campaign Launch Party’ where they are offering free pizza to attendees.”. A screen shot of the invitation was provided as evidence and Marshia Paulton and Jerrilyn Roberson were also provided as witnesses.

After review from the Election Board, a quorum of 4 out of the 6 board members voted to dismiss the complaint because it did not state a cause of action for which relief may be granted and the complaint is not a violation of the Election Code (Chapter 101, Article 1, Section 4).

Parties may be accompanied by any other student from whom they can receive counsel and have the option to be represented by counsel.

Any appeals must be directed towards the Supreme Court of the Student Government of Texas State University.

All meetings of the Election Board are open to public and recorded. These records are available upon the request.
