

Dear Mass Communication Student:

Effective with the 2008 catalog (becomes effective fall 2008) degree programs in Mass Communication are being reduced to 120 hours from the current 128 hours. Likewise the advanced hour requirement is being reduced to 36 hours from the current 39 advanced hours.

Students have the option of staying in their current catalog or moving to the 2008 catalog. For most students moving to the 2008 catalog will be a positive choice. However, there could be drawbacks as well. Also, students staying in their current catalog may be subject to changes in future course options as a result of curriculum changes.

Students who are planning on graduating fall 2008 or after should check with their academic advisor to see how moving to the new catalog may affect them. Students graduating in May 2008 or August 2008 are subject to their current catalog and are not eligible to be move to the 2008 catalog.
