
**STANDING ORDERS OF THE COURT:**

The Court issues the following standing orders as a means of guidelines for hearings and public meetings before the Court. All persons wishing to address the Court shall abide by the standing orders.


- I. STAND when addressing the court, including making objections.
- II. ASK Court for permission to approach the witness.
- III. ADDRESS all remarks to the Court, not opposing counsel or opposing parties.
- IV. EVERYONE has a TITLE: Mr., Mrs., Justice, Honorable, ETC. No first Names.
- V. TURN OFF or SILENCE your electronic devices.
- VI. DRESS appropriately. Business casual at the very least.
- VII. FILE your briefs. It is difficult for the court to be informed if we do not have a brief on file.
- VIII. Show up to all pre-trial hearings as scheduled by the court.

We, the Justices of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Session of the Supreme Court hereby enact the standing orders this 2<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2017.


