Prerequisites

*All core curriculum must be completed. Completion of the foreign language requirement (if required). Occupational Emphasis and electives must be completed. Must be in the last semester of the degree. 12 of the 18 hours completed in the Professional Development with a 2.25 GPA or higher. 2.00 GPA with Texas State.*

*It is recommended that all 18 hours in the Professional Development be completed, especially if you are a part-time student. The prerequisites must be posted to your Texas State transcript to register. The courses in the Professional Development must relate to the student's internship project.*

All students planning to enroll in the internship course MUST attend an orientation session the semester prior to enrolling in OCED 4360. Students must attend one of the following sessions on days, times, and location indicated if enrolling during Spring 2010.
