<sup>1</sup> Students who plan to pursue a minor in Biology should select BIOL 1406 and 1407.  
<sup>2</sup> Select both Modern Language courses from French (FREN), German (GERM), Japanese (JAPN), or Spanish (SPAN).  
<sup>3</sup> Select one course from the Social and Behavioral Science component area (080) of ACC's Core Curriculum list. Students who plan to major in Anthropology may not satisfy this component area with ANTH 2351.  
<sup>4</sup> Select one ENGL course from the Humanities component area (040) of ACC's Core Curriculum list.  
<sup>5</sup> Select one course from the Visual and Performing Arts component area (050) of ACC's Core Curriculum list.  
<sup>6</sup> The number of electives a student needs to complete depends on the number of hours a student needs to achieve the required 128 hour minimum, which must include at least 39 advanced hours and at least 9 hours of writing intensive (WI) courses.  
<sup>7</sup> Students who plan to major in Anthropology (BS) must select a lab-based science minor, which includes biology, chemistry, physics, geology, geography, computer science, or mathematics.

**NOTES:**

1. *Italicized* courses satisfy both ACC and Texas State Core Curriculum requirements. Courses in (parentheses) indicate the course transfer equivalents at Texas State. Courses marked with an asterisk (\*) must be completed with a grade of "D" or higher.
2. Texas State will apply to a degree up to 66 hours from an accredited two-year college (6-8 hours may be added with college dean approval.)
3. Students may elect to complete courses in a different sequence where possible, but should consult a counselor/advisor before doing so.
4. Upon completion of certain course requirements at Texas State, students may elect to send these hours back to ACC to be applied toward an associate's degree. This is commonly referred to as "reverse transfer."

## TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY-SAN MARCOS

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### UNIVERSITY ADMISSION:

1. Submit completed ApplyTexas Application form, \$40 application fee, and all credentials to the Texas State Office of Undergraduate Admissions by the stated deadline (Fall-July 1, Spring-December 1, Summer I-May 1, Summer II-June 15).
2. Submit an official transcript from each institution attended to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. Students must be eligible to return (e.g., free of suspension, dismissal, or enforced withdrawal) to all previous institutions regardless of grade point average (GPA) or degrees received.
3. A minimum 2.25 grade point average (GPA) in all transferable courses is required. In computing the GPA, grades of "A", "B", "C", "D", and "F" are computed as recorded. Grades of "W", "P", "Q", and "X" are disregarded and grades of "WF" and "I" are averaged as "F". Grades in non-transferable and technical/vocational courses are disregarded.
