<sup>1</sup> This course transfers in as PSY ELNA (Elective Not Advanced). However, it will be used to meet the PSY 3300 requirement.  
<sup>2</sup> Select one ENGL course from the Humanities component area (040) of ACC's Core Curriculum.  
<sup>3</sup> These courses transfer in as BIO ELNA (Elective Not Advanced). If both courses are taken at ACC, they may be used to satisfy the BIO 2451 and 2452 (Anatomy & Physiology) Requirement. Students may not take one at ACC and the other at Texas State. Both must be taken at the same institution.  
<sup>4</sup> Select one course from the Visual and Performing Arts component area (050) of ACC's Core Curriculum.  
<sup>5</sup> Must be taken at Texas State.  
<sup>6</sup> May be required, depending on the number of core curriculum hours transferred and should be chosen in coordination with an academic advisor.  
 If U S 1100 is not required, a one-hour elective may be required in order to meet the minimum hours required for the degree.

- NOTES:**
1. *Italicized* courses satisfy both ACC and Texas State Core Curriculum requirements. Courses in (parentheses) indicate the course transfer equivalents at Texas State.
  2. If two years of the same foreign language were not completed in high school, students must take 6-8 hours of the same foreign language.
  3. If one year of computer science was not completed in high school, students must take one semester of CS 1308 or CIS 1323 or equivalent.
  4. Texas State will apply to a degree up to 66 hours from an accredited two-year college (6-8 hours may be added with college dean approval.)
  5. Students may elect to complete courses in a different sequence where possible, but should consult a counselor/advisor before doing so.
  6. Upon completion of certain course requirements at Texas State, students may elect to send these hours back to ACC to be applied toward an associate's degree. This is commonly referred to as "reverse transfer."

## TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY-SAN MARCOS

### UNIVERSITY ADMISSION:

1. Submit completed ApplyTexas Application form, application fee, and all credentials to the Texas State Office of Undergraduate Admissions by the stated deadline (Fall-July 15, Spring-November 15, Summer I-May 1, Summer II-June 15).
2. Submit an official transcript from each institution attended to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. Students must be eligible to return (e.g., free of suspension, dismissal, or enforced withdrawal) to all previous institutions regardless of grade point average (GPA) or degrees received.
3. A minimum 2.25 grade point average (GPA) in all transferable courses is required. In computing the GPA, grades of A, B, C, D, and F are computed as recorded. Grades of W, P, Q, and X are disregarded and grades of WF and I are averaged as F. Grades in non-transferable and technical/vocational courses are disregarded.
4. Submit an application for on-campus housing, if required, or apply to live off campus.

Students transferring directly to Texas State University-San Marcos from a community college may elect to follow the Texas State catalog in effect at the time they entered the community college, or any subsequent catalog upon approval of the Dean of their College. Students are reminded to refer to their designated catalog for information relating to University, College, and/or Departmental requirements for curriculum, graduation, probation/suspension, and other general information.

### ADMISSION TO THE NURSING PROGRAM:

Admission to the undergraduate major in Nursing is competitive and selective, and the student must apply and be accepted to the St. David's School of Nursing. The student is encouraged to obtain academic advising prior to submitting an admission's application. The application deadline is January 15th. The following criteria must be met for admission consideration:

1. Satisfactory completion of all general core and pre-requisite courses with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
2. Completion of NURS 1200 Introduction to Nursing with a minimum grade of C.
3. Complete Texas State nursing application.
4. Complete all required science courses no more than 5 years prior to the expected date of entrance into the nursing program.
5. The nursing program currently only accepts students on an annual basis. Cohorts begin the program each fall semester.
