<sup>1</sup> Select two Modern Language courses from one of the following languages: American Sign Language, Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Japanese, Russian, or Spanish. The freshman-level language courses from ACC satisfy the Communication component area (011) of ACC's Core Curriculum. Therefore students who complete the freshman-level language courses at ACC do NOT need to take SPCH 1311 to satisfy the (011) requirement. Additionally, the two sophomore-level courses must be from the same language as the freshman-level courses.

<sup>2</sup> Select from the following: ANTH 2301; GEOG 1301; GEOL 1305, 1345, 1403, 1404, 1445; BIOL 1406, 1407, 1408, 1413, 1424, 2304/2101, 2305/2102, 2420, 2421; CHEM 1305/1105, 1311/1111, 1312/1112, 2323/2123, 2325/2125; COSC 1315, 1320, 2415; MATH 1324, 1316, 1333, 1342, 2412, 2413, 2414, 2415, 2420; PHYS 1401, 1402, 1405, 1407, 2425, or 2426.

<sup>3</sup> Select one ENGL course from the Humanities component area (040/041) of ACC's Core Curriculum list.

<sup>4</sup> Select any course from the Visual and Performing Arts component area (050) of ACC's Core Curriculum list.

<sup>5</sup> Select one course from the Social Science component area (080) of ACC's Core Curriculum.

**NOTES:**

1. *Italicized* courses satisfy both ACC and Texas State Core Curriculum requirements. Courses in (parentheses) indicate the course transfer equivalents at Texas State.
2. Texas State will apply to a degree up to 66 hours from an accredited two-year college (6-8 hours may be added with college dean approval.)
3. Students may elect to complete courses in a different sequence where possible, but should consult a counselor/advisor before doing so.
4. Upon completion of certain course requirements at Texas State, students may elect to send these hours back to ACC to be applied toward an associate's degree. This is commonly referred to as "reverse transfer."

### UNIVERSITY ADMISSION:

1. Submit ApplyTexas Admission Application online ([www.ApplyTexas.org](http://www.ApplyTexas.org)), application fee, and all credentials to the Texas State Undergraduate Admissions Office by the stated deadline: [www.admissions.txstate.edu/future/transfer/deadlines.html](http://www.admissions.txstate.edu/future/transfer/deadlines.html)
2. Submit an official transcript from each institution attended to the Undergraduate Admissions Office. Students must be eligible to return (e.g., free of suspension, dismissal, or enforced withdrawal) to all previous institutions regardless of grade point average (GPA) or degrees received.
3. A minimum 2.25 grade point average (GPA) in all transferable courses is required. In computing the GPA, grades of A, B, C, D, and F are computed as recorded. Grades of W, P, Q, and X are disregarded and grades of WF and I are averaged as F. Grades in non-transferable and technical/vocational courses are disregarded.
4.
