NOTES:

- Italicized* courses satisfy both Blinn and Texas State Core Curriculum requirements. Courses in (parentheses) indicate the course transfer equivalents at Texas State.
- Texas State will apply to a degree up to 66 hours from an accredited two-year college (6-8 hours may be added with college dean approval.)
- Students may elect to complete courses in a different sequence where possible, but should consult a counselor/advisor before doing so.
- If two years of the same foreign language were not completed in high school, students must take 6-8 hours of the same foreign language.

UNIVERSITY ADMISSION:

1. Submit completed Texas Common Application, \$40 application fee, and all credentials to the Undergraduate Admissions Office by the stated admission deadline (Fall-July 1, Spring-December 1, Summer I-May 1, Summer II-June 15).
2. Submit an official transcript from each institution attended to the Undergraduate Admissions Office.
3. A minimum 2.25 grade point average (GPA) in all transferable courses is required.

Students transferring directly to Texas State University-San Marcos from a two-year college may elect to follow the Texas State catalog in effect at the time they entered the two-year college, or any subsequent catalog upon approval of the Dean of their College. Students are reminded to refer to their designated catalog for information relating to the University and College requirements for curriculum, graduation, probation/ suspension, and other general information.
