<sup>4</sup> For the Statistics requirement, SOCI 3307 is recommended for Sociology minors.  
<sup>5</sup> May be required, depending on the number of core curriculum hours transferred and should be chosen in coordination with an academic advisor. If US 1100 is not required, a one-hour elective may be required in order to meet the minimum hours required for the degree.

**NOTES:**

1. *Italicized* courses satisfy both LCC and Texas State Core Curriculum requirements. Courses in (parentheses) indicate the course transfer equivalents at Texas State.
2. Texas State will apply to a degree up to 66 hours from an accredited two-year college (6-8 hours may be added with college dean approval.)
3. Students may elect to complete courses in a different sequence where possible, but should consult a counselor/advisor before doing so.
4. If two years of the same foreign language were not completed in high school, students must take 6-8 hours of the same foreign language.
5. Upon completion of certain course requirements at Texas State, students may elect to send these hours back to LCC to be applied toward an associate's degree. This is commonly referred to as "reverse transfer."

## TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY-SAN MARCOS

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### UNIVERSITY ADMISSION:

1. Submit completed ApplyTexas Application, \$40 application fee, and all credentials to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions by the stated admission deadline (Fall-July 1, Spring-December 1, Summer I-May 1, Summer II-June 15).
2. Submit an official transcript from each institution attended to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions.
3. A minimum 2.25 grade point average (GPA) in all transferable courses is required.

Students transferring directly to Texas State University-San Marcos from a two-year college may elect to follow the Texas State catalog in effect at the time they entered the two-year college, or any subsequent catalog upon approval of the Dean of their College. Students are reminded to refer to their designated catalog for information relating to the University and College requirements for curriculum, graduation, probation/ suspension, and other general information.
