**Expenses not covered:**

Flight (estimate \$1,300-\$1,500).

Food and incidentals (\$20/day).

Health insurance: Coverage for the duration of the program is included with program fee.

Accommodations: Our group stays in a modern dorm, Campus Viva, just a brief walk to our language school SDI München. Each room has 2 beds (bunk), a small bathroom, and a kitchenette. Basic bedding, dishes, and cookware are provided. Each room has wireless internet. The dorm has a very small workout area with a treadmill and a few free weights. There are coin-operated washers and dryers in the common area. There is no A/C. You may request to room with a specific person, but it's not guaranteed.

Meals: No meal plan is offered. The program fee includes 19 lunch tickets for the school cafeteria for the 19 class days. You will need to budget for all other meals.

Transportation: Students receive a commuter pass for all public transit within the city limits. The program fee also covers train fares to our day trip locations.

Group excursions and day trips: All admission fees to museums during required excursions are covered through program fee.

Travel outside of the program: Please plan any extra travel for before or after program dates. There is no "free weekend." All weekends are scheduled, and many weekday afternoons also feature group outings.

Conduct: Participants represent TX State University. Responsible behavior is a must and all students sign a contract. You will be sent back for excessive drinking or for illegal drug use.

Academics: The purpose of the program is to advance your language skills and cultural competency. Students must use German consistently, also outside of the classroom, must go to all classes unless ill, and must attend all sightseeing events and day trips.

Daily schedule: You will attend 4.5 hours of class on weekdays and an additional 90-minute grammar course per week. SDI instructors teach the daily classes. Dr. Siwak teaches the grammar course.

Selection process: During the first week of classes in January, our German faculty will review all applications submitted thus far and rank them according to the student's need to go abroad, punctuality and attendance in German classes, German GPA, and ability to function in a group. Once we have ranked all applicants, you will be notified of your acceptance status.
