Catalog designation determines the curriculum and other academic policies that apply to a student. Students must graduate within six years of the semester used to designate their catalog; otherwise, they are subject to the curriculum and academic policies of a subsequent catalog. Students must be accepted by the Graduate College before enrolling in 5000 level courses.</p> <p>^b For course options, see the 2017 catalog.</p> <p>^c Foreign Language Requirement. Students who did not satisfactorily complete at least two years of the same foreign language in high school must complete two semesters (6-8 hours) of a single foreign language as part of the degree requirements.</p> <p>^d Accounting Electives. Please see a graduate accounting advisor for scheduling assistance.</p> <p>^e Business Electives. Please see a graduate accounting advisor for scheduling assistance.</p> <p>Writing Intensive Courses Requirement. Three courses (9 hours) designated as “writing intensive” (WI) must be completed at Texas State to satisfy degree requirements.</p> <p>MAcy Admission Requirements. A Texas State Accounting major may apply for admittance to the MAcy program once the student has completed at least 90 credit hours, 12 upper-level Accounting courses, including ACC 3313 and ACC 3314 with a grade of ‘B’ or better. All applicants to the MAcy program will provide at least two completed reference forms, GMAT or GRE score, and an essay on the topic indicated in the application materials. However, submission of the GMAT or GRE score and essay will be optional for a Texas State Accounting major who has earned a 3.2 GPA or higher in the last 60 hours of coursework, 3.4 or higher in upper-level Accounting courses, and provides at least two reference forms from Texas State faculty.</p> <p>Students should note that not all courses are taught each semester. IMPORTANT DEGREE INFORMATION

DEGREE SUMMARY. Each student may access their degree plan through Degree Works on CatsWeb (<https://ssb.txstate.edu>) by clicking the “Student” link and then “Degree Audit.” Students should consult with their undergraduate advisor (115 McCoy Hall) for the BBA and their graduate advisor (431 McCoy Hall) for the MAcy.

TRANSFER COURSE WORK. A maximum of 72-hours from a community college may be transferred into Texas State to apply toward the BBA degree. Courses acceptable for transfer to Texas State will transfer at the level at which the courses were taken (i.e., acceptable business courses from two-year schools transfer as freshman or sophomore courses and may not be used to satisfy junior/senior level business course requirements). With prior approval, a maximum of six graduate credit hours from an AACSB accredited school may be transferred into Texas State to apply toward the MAcy degree.

UNDERGRADUATE 50% REQUIREMENT. A minimum of 50% of the semester hours for a business degree must come from courses offered by the McCoy College of Business Administration at Texas State University.

OTHER DEGREE REQUIREMENTS. Students must complete at least 150 semester hours, satisfy course requirements specified above and on their degree audit (including general education core, foreign language, writing intensive, and advanced hours course requirements), satisfy the comprehensive examination for the MAcy degree and achieve minimum grade point averages as follows: 2.0 Texas State GPA, 2.25 Business GPA (common business core, major, and restricted advanced business electives), 2.5 Undergraduate ACC Major GPA and a 3.0 Graduate Major GPA.

APPLICATION FOR GRADUATION. Students must apply to graduate online via CatsWeb (<http://www.catsweb.txstate.edu/students.html>) the first week of the semester in which they expect to complete both the BBA and MAcy. Additionally, it is the student’s responsibility to check with their undergraduate and graduate advisor prior to the semester in which they expect to graduate (August for Fall, January for Spring or June for Summer) for clearance to participate in commencement.

UNDERGRADUATE HONORS DESIGNATION. To be eligible to graduate with honors, students must complete a minimum of 54 credit hours through Texas State and have earned a 3.4 or higher Texas State GPA.
