2. Must be in the top 25 percent of their graduating high school class or have a GPA of at least 3.25 if continuing or transfer student, or continuing graduate students must have a GPA of at least 3.5. Complete this RFSA Scholarship Application.
3. Must be enrolled for 12 hours per semester for undergraduate; 6 hours for graduate.
