Texas State University Emergency Operations Plan (#776)

Mr. Algoe reviewed the revisions to the Texas State University Emergency Operations Plan and discussed how this plan interfaces with the Rapid Response Team process (i.e., the Red Team). Mr. Algoe clarified that the Emergency Operations Plan describes an all-hazard approach to how Texas State will respond to and manage campus emergencies. The Red Team will make high-level executive decisions. Mr. Algoe will add more clarification of the role of the Red Team in the Emergency Operations Plan.

President Trauth discussed commencement. Provost Bourgeois will develop a Qualtrics survey to determine whether faculty, staff, and students would have concerns about attending a commencement ceremony in December 2020. President Trauth discussed messaging to remind students to be mindful of their responsibilities during the upcoming holidays.
