Cody DeSalvo v. The Election Board

ON APPLICTION FOR INJUCTION

Issued January 31, 2020

The application for Injunction Relief was submitted by Mr. Cody DeSalvo, hereafter referred to as the Respondent upon a ruling by the Election Board which stopped campaigning in LBJSC and required Authorization from Student Involvement.

The request for Injunctive Relief was received by Chief Justice William Frank-Cadoree and referred by him to the Supreme Court.

The Respondent intends to file an appeal with the Supreme Court and is request Injunctive Relief from the Election Board opinion that was sent via email to all Candidates and from the PowerPoint presentation of the Rules Reading Seminar pertaining to prohibition on campaign in LBJSC.

Court Order

Injunctions are instruments used by this Court to stop actions which may cause a person imminent or immediate harm in their dealings with Student Government.

Consistent with this standard, several questions related to the Election Board's interpretive findings were brought forward by the Justices. This Court finds actionable issues on each of these topics. These concerns all sufficiently meet or exceed what should reasonably be required for the issuance of an injunction.

It is the opinion of the Chief Justice that additional, unnecessary harm could occur should the Respondent's campaign should be prohibited from campaigning in LBJ.

Therefore, the Request for Injunctive Relief is granted.

Chief Justice William Frank-Cadoree hereby orders all members of Student Government, including the Election Board, not to bring into effect or enforce the provisions of the Email and PowerPoint that prohibited Campaigning in LBJSC and receiving authorization from Student Involvement so that they may campaign in LBJSC.

In addition, be advise to all Candidates this order does not give permission to Campaign in LBJSC Teaching Theater. According to Title III Chapter 105 Article II Section 12(b) *"Campaigning in the LBJ Student Center Teaching Theater is prohibited."*

A hearing on this topic is tentatively scheduled by this Court for February 4th 2020.

It is so ordered.
