



Job Description- Aquatic Maintenance Worker

Supervisor:

Assistant Director of Facility Operations

Job Description/Purpose/Primary Function of Position:

Pool Maintenance Worker will assist Assistant Director with the daily operations of the Aqua Sports Center & the Student Recreation Center Natatorium and provide him/her with input in reference to policy and procedures.

Qualifications:

- Strong work ethic and ability to work without direct supervision

Job Duties:

- Cleaning and sanitizing tile, stainless steel and deck areas
- Trash and lost and found detail work
- Vacuum pools on a weekly basis
- Scrub tile and vertical walls of pools
- Utilize and maintain floor scrubbing machine and power washing equipment
- Test water chemistry and log findings
- Replenish chlorine and acid supplies
- Assist in maintaining a clean and safe work environment
- Complete other duties as assigned

Wages/Scheduling:

- Hours will need to be centered around pool closures to perform some duties, but otherwise a fairly flexible schedule.

Evaluation:

- Assist in the evaluation and maintain inventory of all equipment for the pool.
- Log in all performed maintenance

Other:

In accordance with the Student Affairs Division/Campus Recreation Office Strategic Plan, other duties as assigned.
