

DYI FLOWER PETAL BOOKMARK

Supplies Needed:

- Scissors
- Hole punch (optional)
- Glue (stick is preferred)
- Construction Paper
- String/Yarn
- Clear Tape
- Flower Petals (Make sure to have your parents help you look for them)



Directions:

1. Cut construction paper in the shape and size you want the bookmark to be. We did a rectangular shape.
2. Apply the glue in whatever design you like. You can have any kind of flower pattern.
3. Gently press flower petals onto the paper. They will stick to the paper wherever you put down the glue
4. Wait for the glue to dry.
5. Place tape over the entire bookmark to secure the petals and to make your bookmark sturdier.
6. Remove excess tape from the edges.
7. Punch a hole in the top of the bookmark with scissors or a hole punch if you have one.
8. Cut a length of string that is twice as long as you'd like the bookmark tassel to be.
9. Fold the string in half and push the folded side through the hole and put the other ends through the loop and pull to secure the string on the bookmark.
10. Now...Voilà, you have a bookmark.
