

Meadows Center Holiday Ornament

Do you need a fun holiday craft that you can hang on your Christmas tree for years to come? Try making one of our Meadows Center holiday ornaments that children can have fun decorating and then proudly hang on the tree with the year you made it, so you will always remember this doing this family friendly activity!

Duration of Activity: 15 Minutes - 30 Minutes

Required Material:

Mason Jar Lid	Scissors
Glue Gun	Construction Paper
Glue Stick	Yarn
Drill (Optional)	Markers
Googly Eyes	Printed Meadows Center Holiday Ornament
Sequins	



Set Up:

Option 1 (With a Drill)

1. Print out the desired number of our Meadows Center Holiday Ornaments sheets.
2. Drill a hole in each Mason Jar lid to loop yarn through to hang later.

Option 1 (No Drill)

1. Tie a loop through the outside ring of the lid, big enough to hang on the tree.
2. Use your hot glue gun to glue the flat part of the lid to the inside of the ring so it stays in place and keeps the string from moving.

Directions:

1. Cut out a Meadows Center Holiday Ornament from the printout and glue to one side of the Mason Jar lid.
2. Decorate the other side of the Mason Jar lid any way you would like with your materials.
3. Attach the yarn to your ornament by looping it through and tying it.
4. Hang your ornament on the tree for everyone to see and do not forget to write the year on it so you'll always have it and know when you made it!
