BFA Sequence:

BFA I = intro to Technical Production (classroom) + shop/PA work
BFA II = entry level production work: shops/show crews/PA/ASM
BFA III = assistant level production work: shop+crew/ASM
BFA IV = management level production work, small venue
BFA V = management level production work, large venue
BFA V(repeat) = advanced level production work (optional)

Admission into BFA sequence requires successful completion of Intro Design and Stagecraft during Freshman year and approval of Head of Technical Production Area.

Continuing in the BFA sequence requires successful completion of BFA assignment each semester plus an end-of-semester review.

Students under this degree program will be required to maintain a MINIMUM Texas State GPA of 2.5.

A grade of "C" or better is required in all Theatre courses while under this degree program.

Non-course based internships in an area of interest are strongly recommended during the summers after Sophomore and Junior years. The BFA 1 course will help students find and apply for these internships.
