"A Resolution in support of Concealed Carry on Campus"

1 **WHEREAS:** the Associated Student Government is a
2 representative body that has the duty to create

8 Senate disagree with the
9 administration's policy that concealed
10 handguns on campus are and should
11 remain prohibited; and

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** that this legislation be used as a
13 means of creating a formal,
14 representative statement on behalf
15 of the majority of Texas State

16 students ONLY and not a means for
17 creating a policy or implementing
18 an action; and
19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** that the legislation be forwarded
20 to ASG Advisor Kathy Weiser, Dean
21 of Students Dr. Margarita
22 Arellano, Vice President for
23 Student Affairs Dr. Joanne Smith
24 and President Dr. Denise Trauth
