

**SLAC's Steps
to
Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Preparation**

1. Visit GRE.org, the web site on which you can register for the GRE, download practice reviews and tests, and check for updates about the test.
2. Take the practice GRE to assess what areas you need to improve in.
3. Since the GRE Verbal section focuses on vocabulary, begin working on this area as soon as possible. SLAC has vocabulary study aids available [HERE](#).
4. Use SLAC's other online exercises under the GRE or Content Area Help [HERE](#).
