Summary and Action Items

- AP Credit Plan: Implementation of the state mandate to award AP credit for a score of 3 was officially implemented on January 4, 2016. Texas State University will award credits to students who are currently enrolled who achieved a score of 3 or greater on an AP exam that was not previously awarded credit. Students who have not already received credit for the relevant course were contacted by the PACE Center. These students were asked to compare the credit to their spring 2016 class schedule, and make any appropriate changes during late registration. Dean Dann Brown is the contact person for issues that arise from this change.
