14 **BE IT RESOLVED:** The Associated Student Government push for a re-  
15 drafting of the facsimile weapon policy  
16 "Facsimile weapons, including, but not limited  
17 to, water pistols, models, pellet guns and "B.B."  
18 guns are prohibited on campus." to read "

22 review and approval from CASO and UPD to avoid  
23 conflict of misinterpretation of facsimile

28 activity that involves a facsimile weapon be  
29 allowed proper review by other relevant  
30 departments to determine legitimacy and
