Completed entire fall semester using the hybrid in-person/virtual model with first year-graduate students. Overall student feedback average for 2020: 4.85. I continued my support of Ms. Jennifer Johnson's Transgender Voice Clinic and developed the bilingual Literacy Clinic with Ms. Linda Johnson with our first client receiving treatment in the spring of 2021.
