

Understanding CRNS & Section Numbers

Section number definitions are effective Spring 2020 (202030) onwards as listed below.

A CRN is a 5 digit-Course Reference Number used to register for a specific section. CRNs that begin with the number 3 are offered in spring, the number 5 are offered in summer and 1 in the fall semesters.

The section number above is 251, for a course in spring semester and is not part of a special group since it does not have a letter represented.

17491	BLAW	2361	H02

The section number above is H02, for a course in fall semester that is restricted to Honors students.

The section number above is 751, for a course in Summer II semester that is not part of a special group since it does not have a letter represented.
