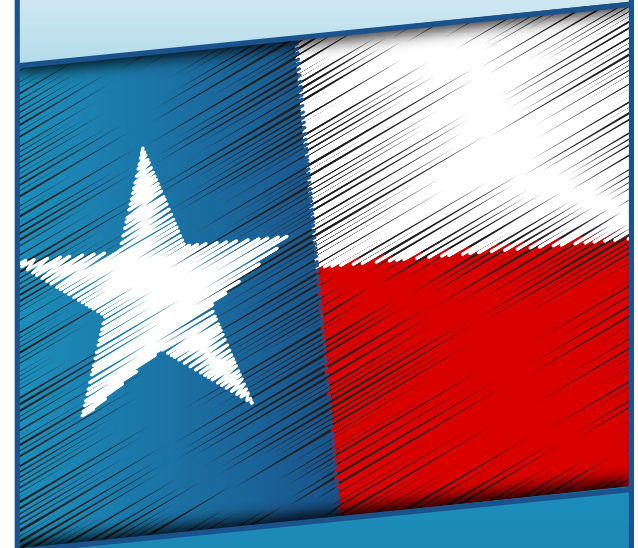

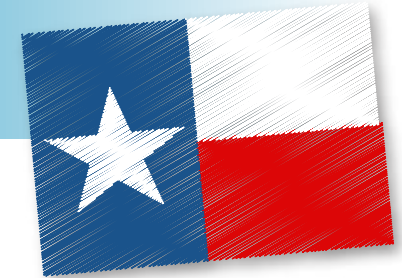

- ★ Opportunity to get answers to questions regarding continuation of cash benefits, Medicare, and Medicaid even while working.
- ★ Meet Community Work Incentive Coordinators and Ticket-to-Work Employment Networks and other community-based employment support representatives.
- ★ Enroll in FREE employment support programs and Work Incentive Planning & Assistance.
