

**Council of Academic Deans Meeting
April 5, 2016**

Summary and Action Items

- Council on Funded Research: Dr. Britt Bousman updated the Council on the work that has been ongoing with the Council on Funded Research.
- 10 Colleges That Attract Most Transfer Students: Dr. Michael Heintze distributed an article from U.S. News and World Reports where they list Texas State University as the 8th school in the nation with the greatest numbers of enrolled transfer students in fall 2014.
- Gun Free Zones for Disciplinary Actions (Campus Carry): As part of the new UPPS on Campus Carry, carve out areas in various locations used for disciplinary matters, legal and quasi-judicial matters, and legal compliance were discussed. Deans were advised to discuss this with their respective college councils. If areas are designated, they should be limited and selectively assigned. Any designated carve out for these purposes would need signage. Participants would need to be notified in advance that the meeting is to be held in a gun free zone.
- Undergraduate Admissions Report: Dr. Heintze provided the Council with the undergraduate admissions report.
- Graduate Admissions Report: Dr. Andrea Golato provided the Council with the graduate admissions report.
