REMINDER: Posting Program/Student Outcomes

This link will be made public on the CACREP website to meet recognition requirements set forth by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA). The information to be posted includes the following four data points regarding each of your accredited specialty areas: (a) number of graduates in the past year, (b) completion rate, (c) licensure or certification examination pass rate, and (d) job placement rate of students/graduates.
