





Q35 - Who was your CHEM 2341 faculty member?









Q44 - Who was your MATH 323 faculty member?





Q46 - Who is your HIST 1320 faculty member?





Q19 - What grade do you expect to make in this course?





Q3 - My SI Leader demonstrated a good understanding of the course content.





Q4 - My SI Leader was prepared and on time for sessions.





Q5 - My SI Leader encouraged me to participate in session activities.





Q6 - My SI Leader was patient, friendly, and courteous.





Q7 - My SI Leader used time efficiently and productively.





Q9 - My professor encouraged me to attend and participate in SI sessions.





Q11 - How many total SI sessions did you attend?





Q12 - Why did you choose not to attend SI sessions?





Q13 - Why did you not meet the required 10 SI session attendance count by 11/8







Q15 - Why did you not meet the required 10 SI session attendance count by 11/8?





Q17 - Why did you choose to continue attending SI sessions after the mandatory period?





Q24 - What motivated you to attend SI sessions?





Q37 - How helpful did you find SI sessions held on Zoom?





Q26 - Should SI count towards course credit?









Q19 - What grade do you expect to make in this course?













Q7 - My SI Leader used time efficiently and productively.





Q9 - My professor encouraged me to attend and participate in SI sessions.





Q11 - How many SI sessions did you attend for this course?









Q25 - How helpful were SI sessions to you?








