









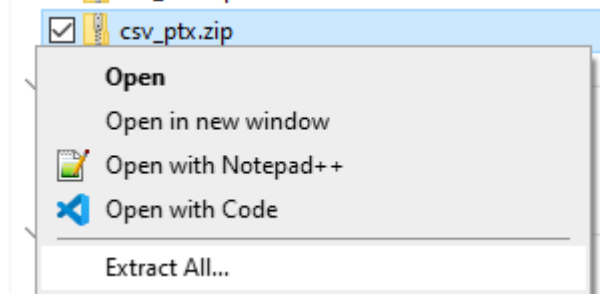


Instructions for accessing 2019 PUMS data through the Census FTP file server



1. Access the FTP site
 - Go to <https://www2.census.gov/programs-surveys/acs/data/pums/>.
2. Open the 2019/ directory
3. Open the 1-Year/ directory
4. Choose the data you'd like to download
 - The syntax of the filenames is as follows [filetype]_[datatype][state]
 - CSV filetype vs unix (SAS) filetype
 - Datatype: "p" indicates population information, "h" indicates housing information
 - State: two character indicating a state's code, ex: "tx" for Texas, "us" for data on the entire US

5. Download data by clicking the filename you chose in step 4
6. Unzip the data
 - Right click your downloaded zip file
 - Click **Extract All...**



- Choose the destination for the files
 - Click Extract
7. View the data
- The zip will contain 2 files, a readme to help you understand the format of the data and the dataset in the filetype you chose
