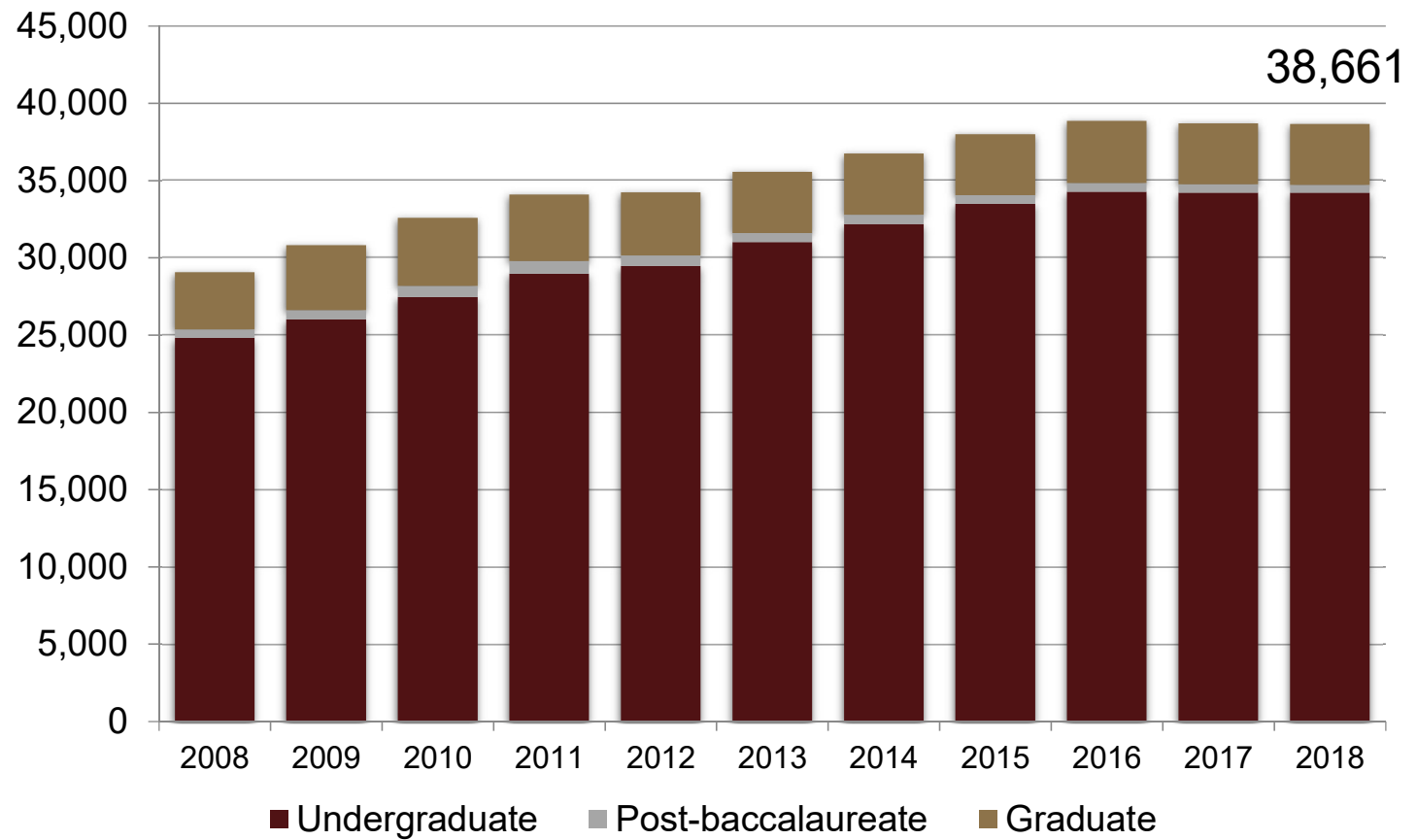


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# Executive Summary

- ❖ Record freshman class of 6,087 – sixth straight record class
- ❖ 10,776 total new undergraduate and graduate students – up 1.8% over fall 2017
- ❖ Doctoral enrollment surpassed 500 for the first time with a record enrollment of 509 students
- ❖ Degrees awarded in FY2018 set new record (8,552)
- ❖ Science and Engineering continues to be the largest college at Texas State University, three years in a row
- ❖ Diversity: 53% of students enrolled at Texas State University are historically underrepresented minorities

# Enrollment History, 2008-2018

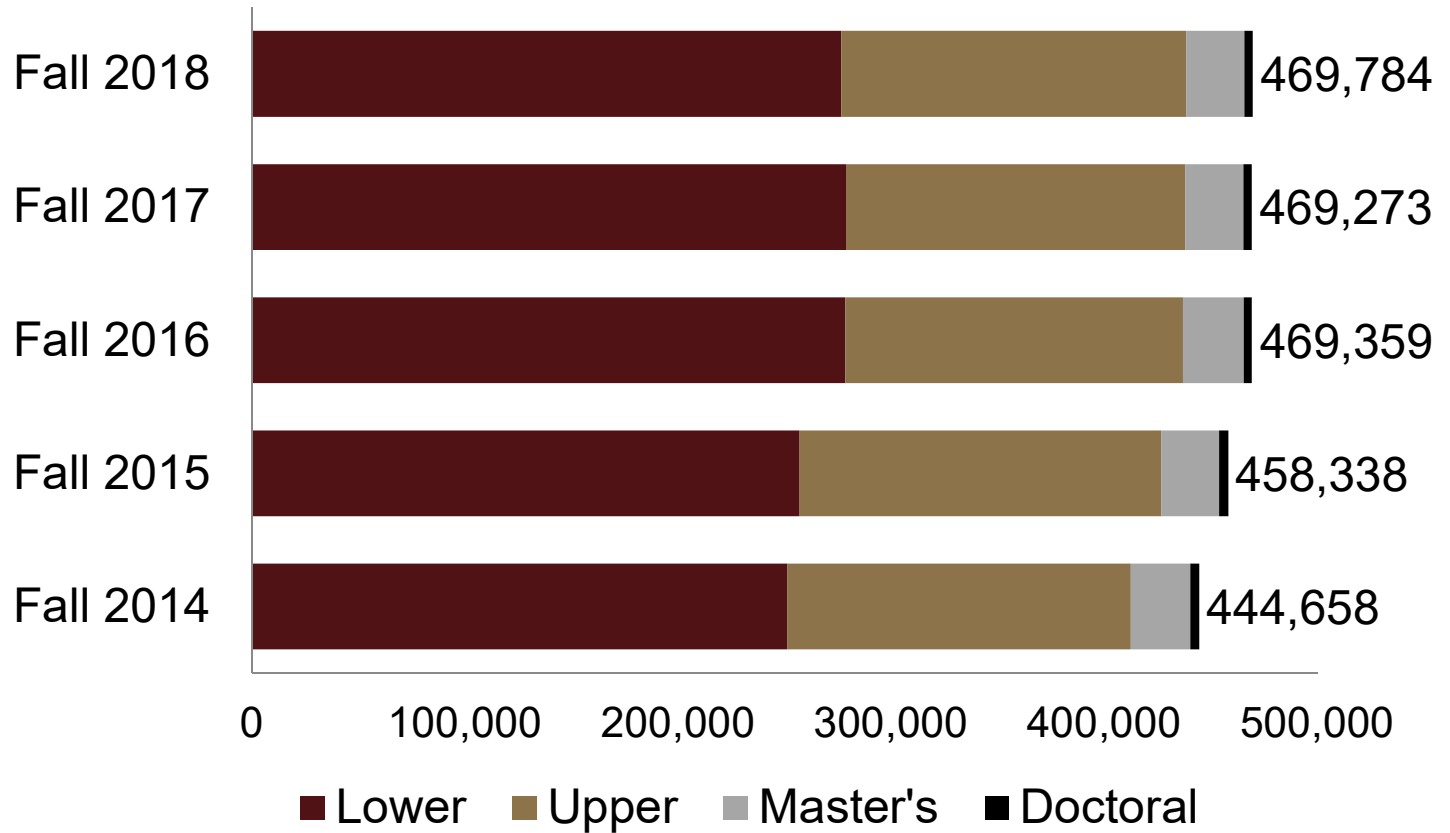

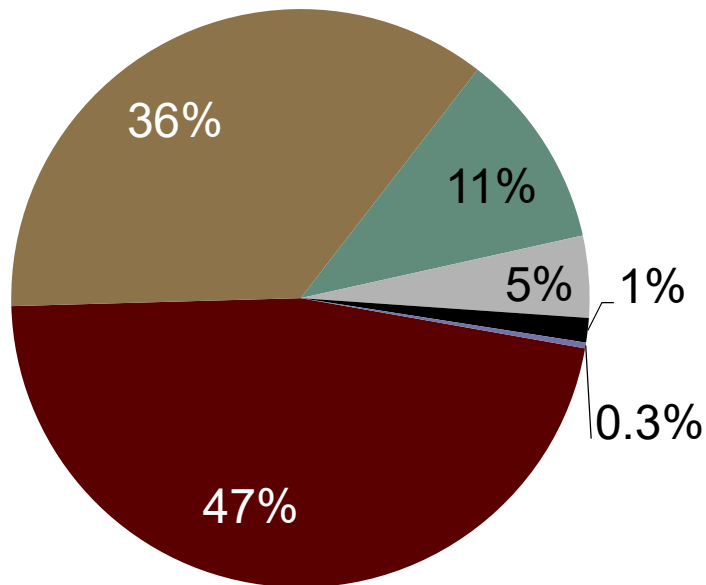
# Semester Credit Hours by Level



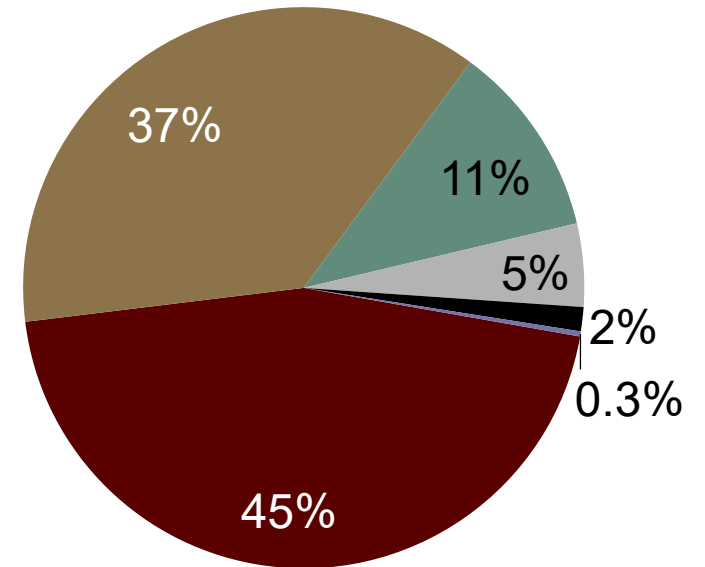

## Fall 2017



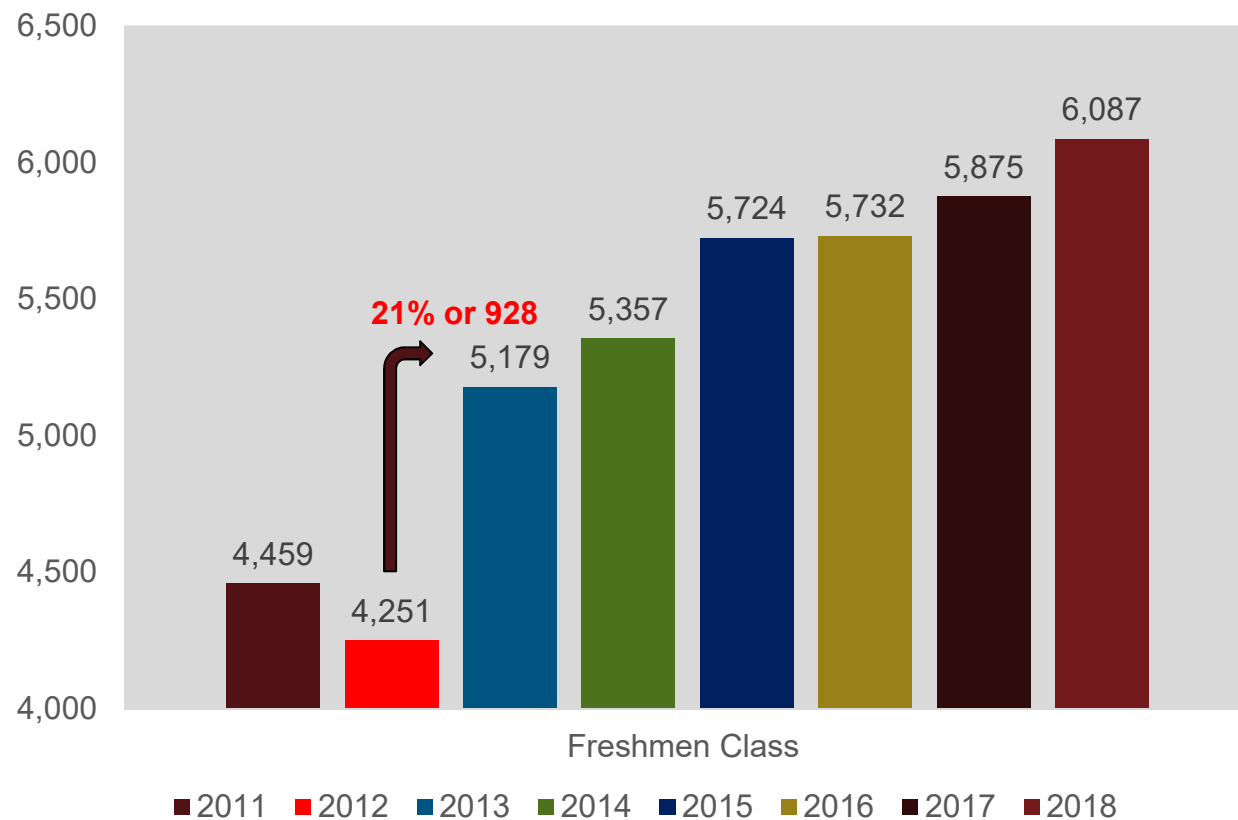

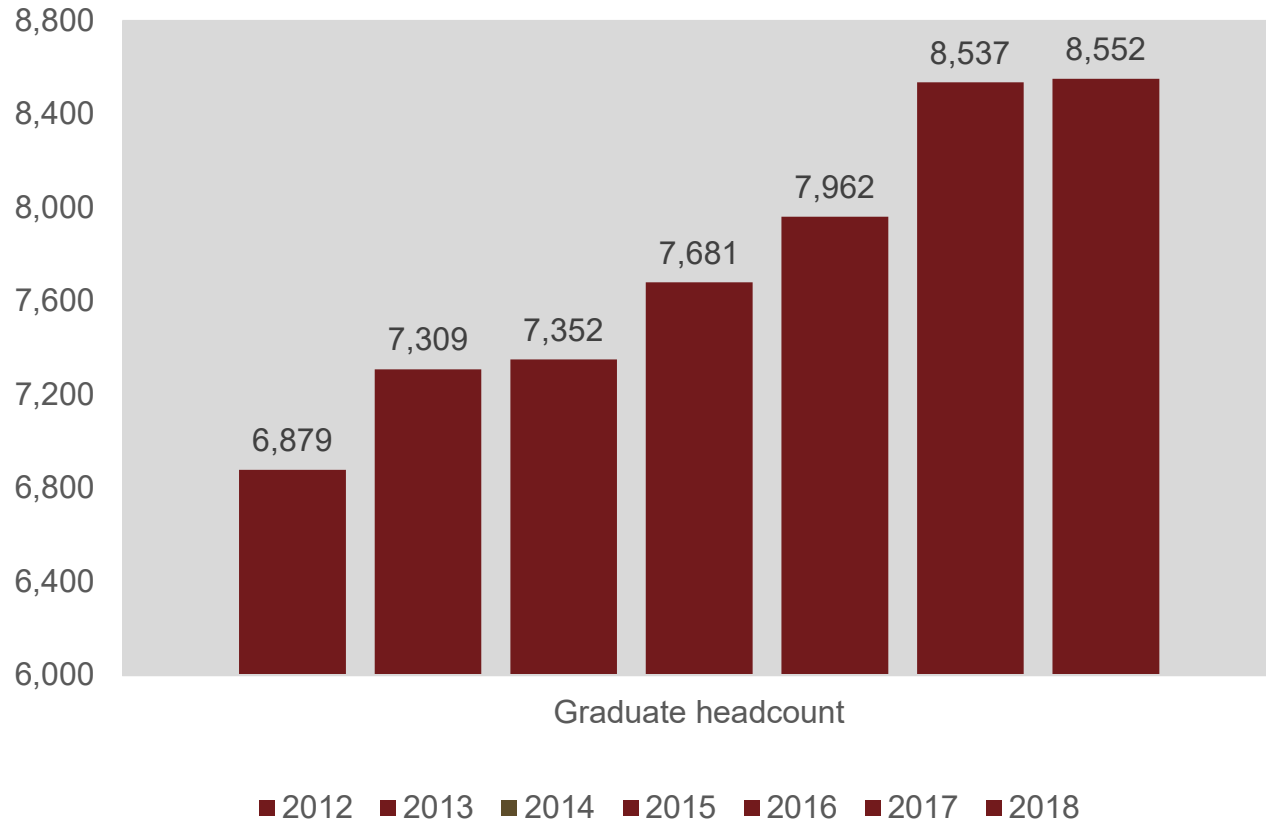

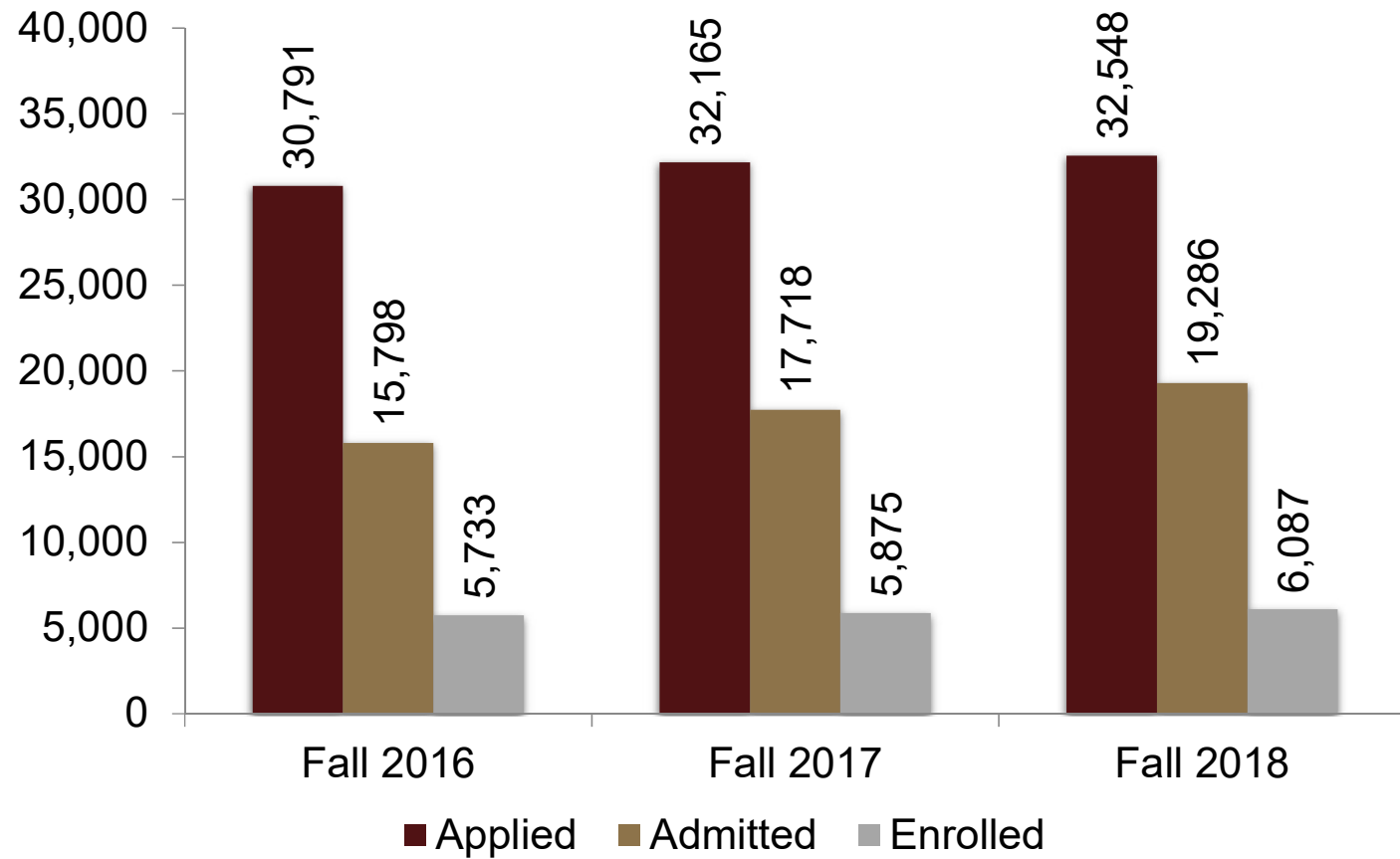

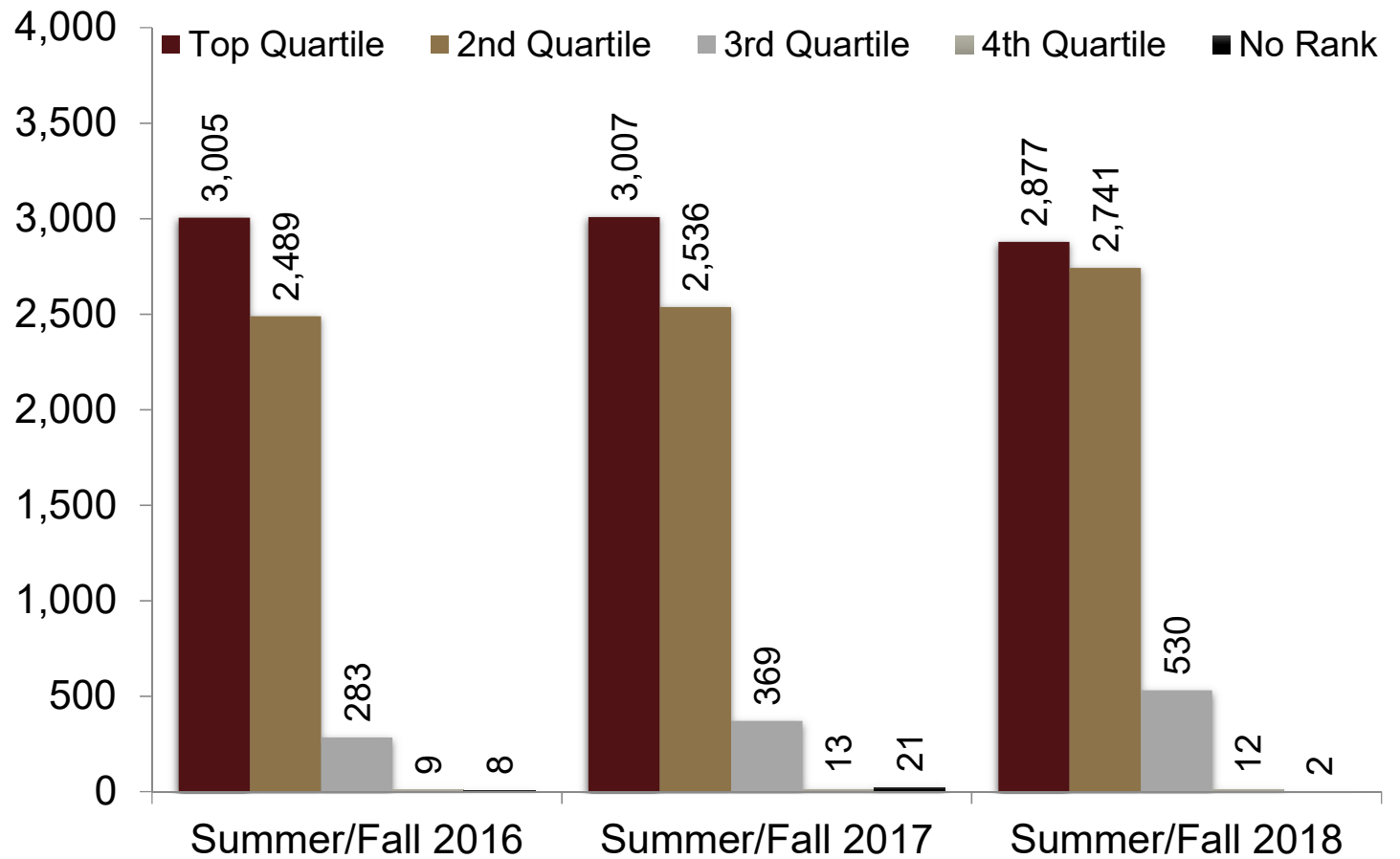

# Freshmen by High School Rank



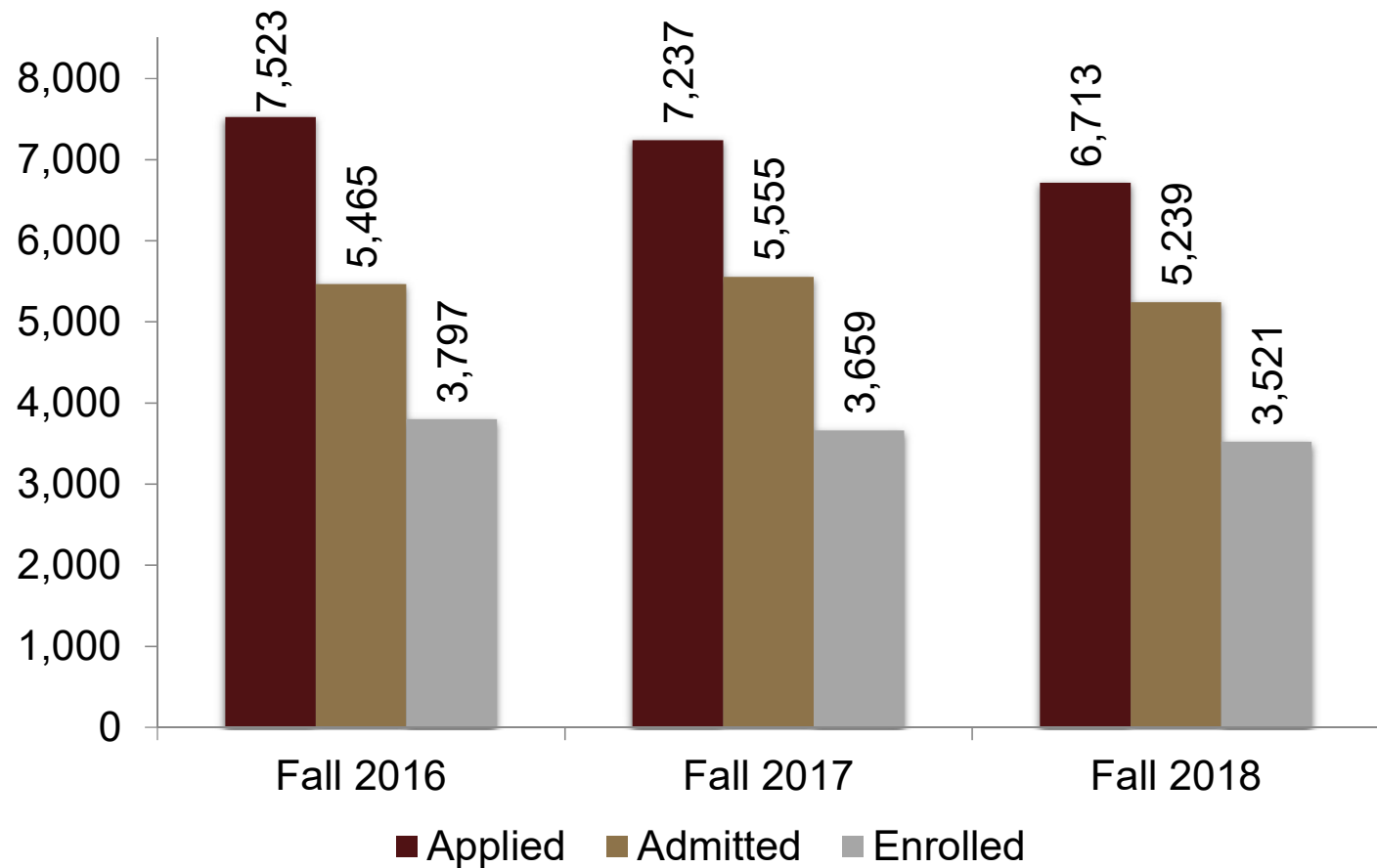

# Transfer Admissions Activity



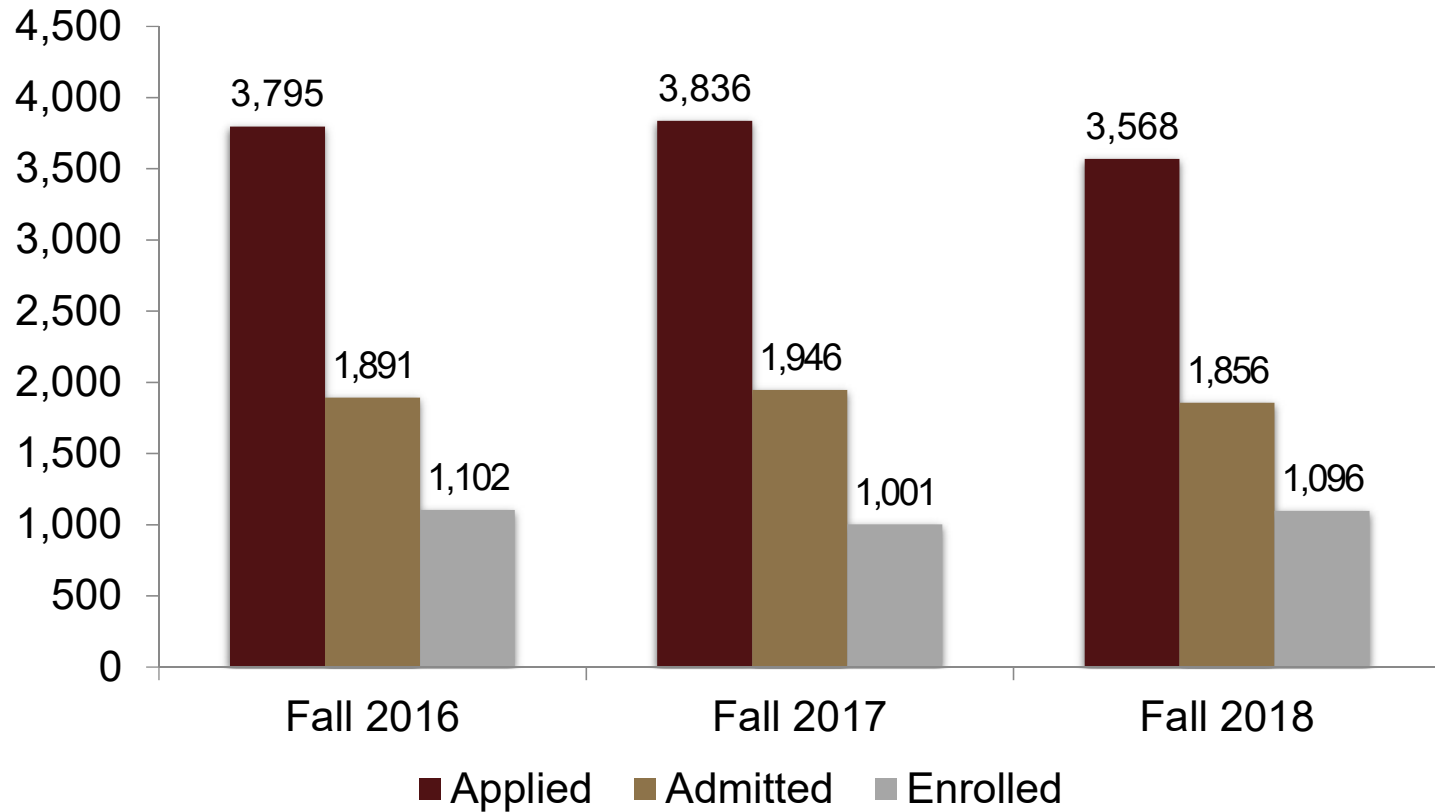

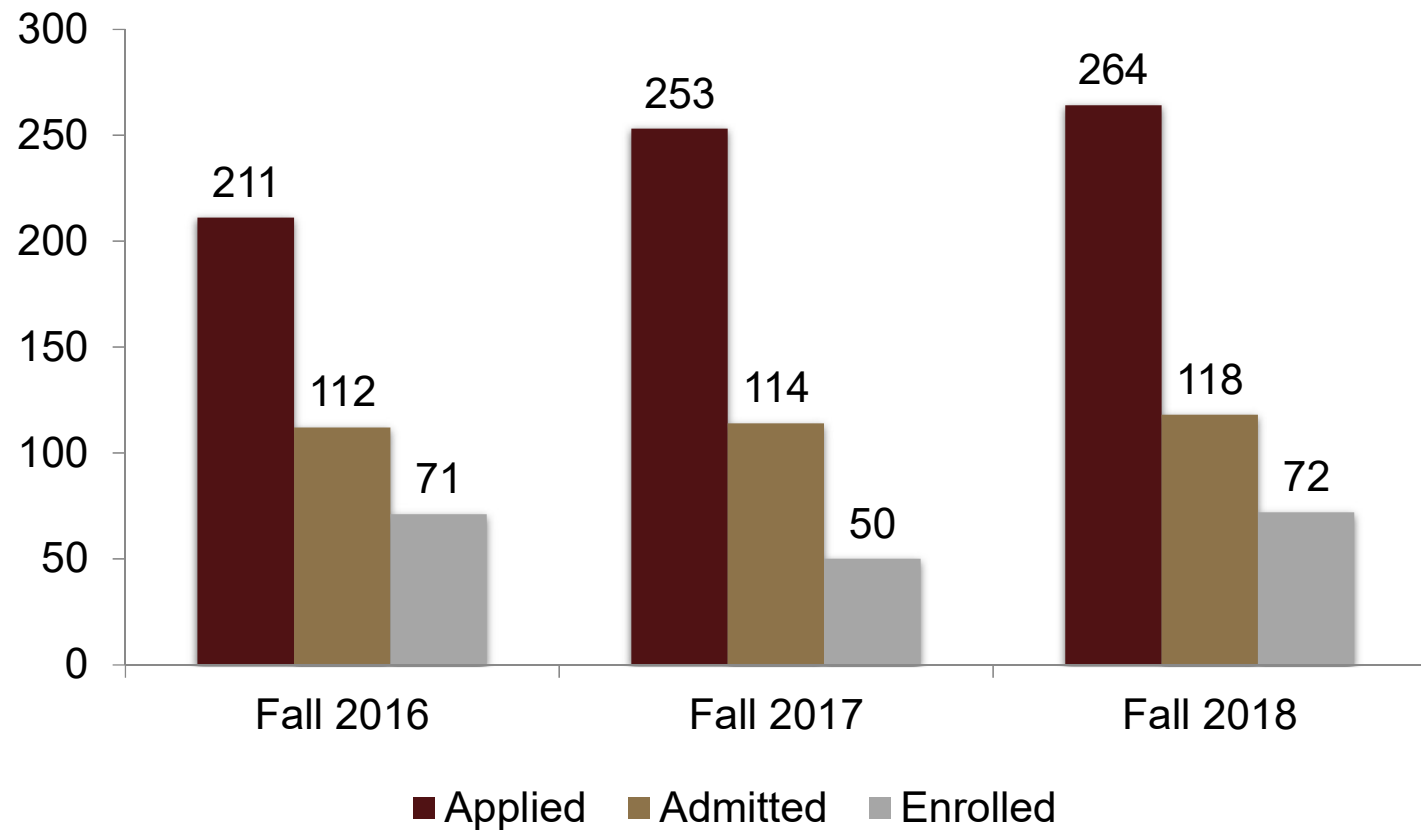

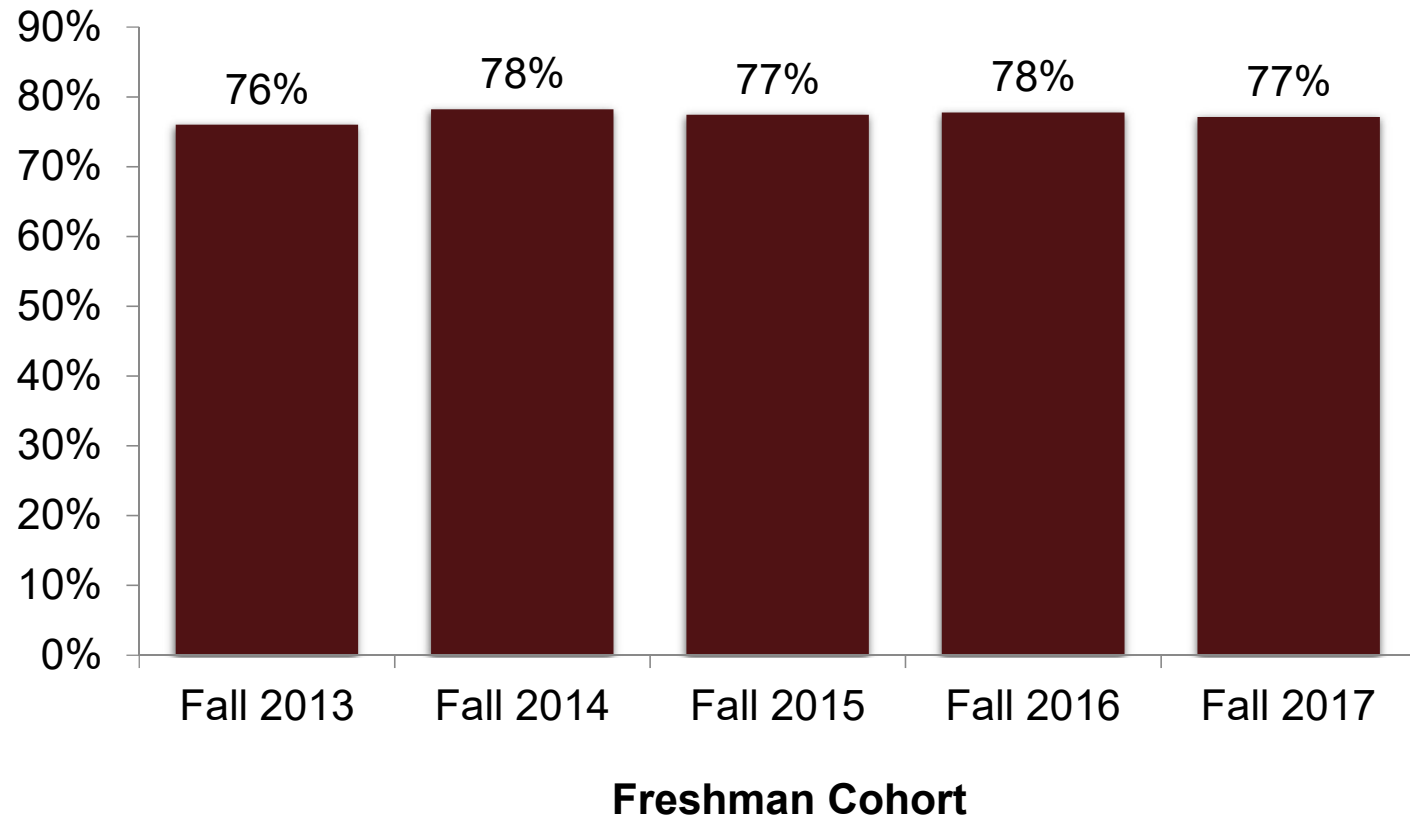
# Doctoral Admissions Activity

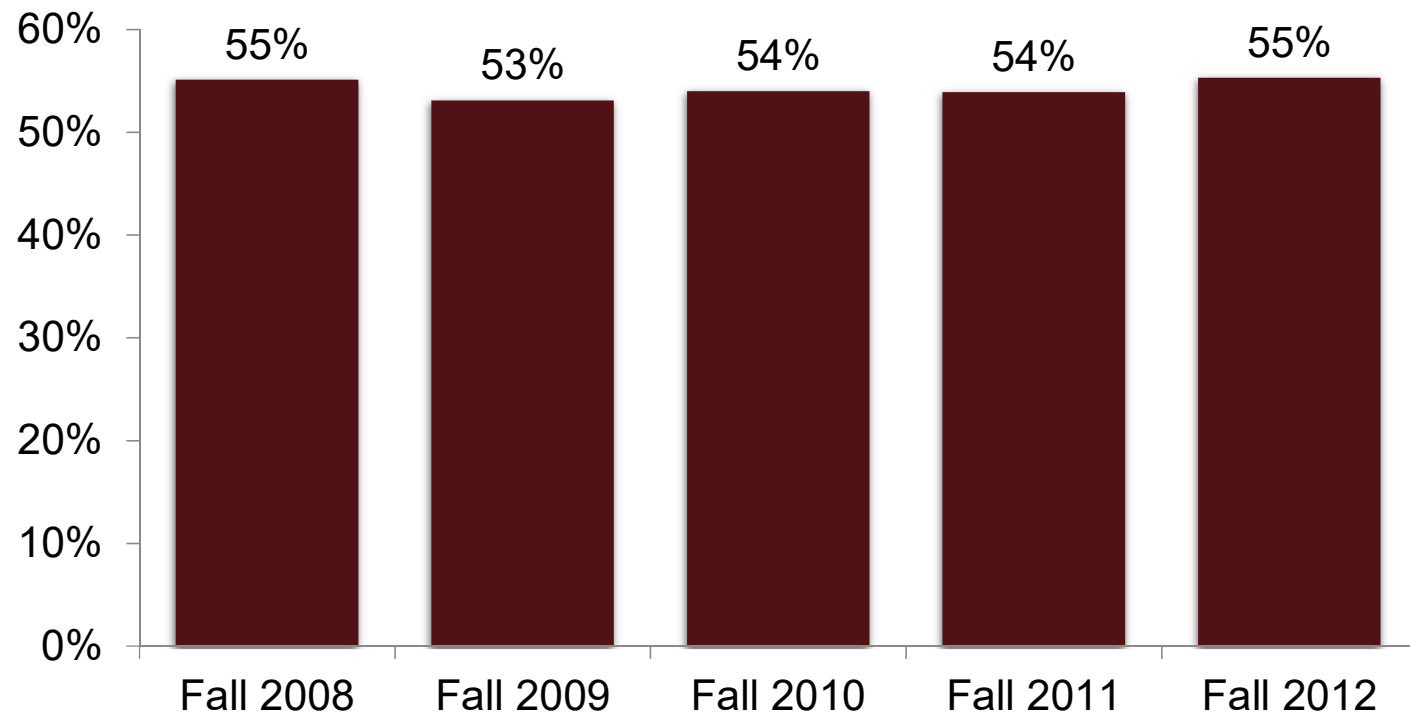


# Freshman Retention Rate
