

Smith-Willms Science Scholarship Nomination Form

Texas State University College of Science and Engineering

Criteria: This scholarship will be awarded to a junior undergraduate student majoring in Biology, Chemistry, or Physics to help provide financial support during the senior year. Nominees will have a record of exceptional academic achievement and will normally have completed three-quarters of the required courses in their major and minor fields. Special consideration will be given to students who have expressed an interest in graduate studies and in pursuing careers in teaching and research. Students who have previously received this scholarship are not eligible to re-apply. In order to receive the award, the successful applicant must remain a full-time Biology, Chemistry, or Physics major.

Award: The award is a one-time tuition credit of \$2,600. The tuition credit will be awarded in the student's senior year fall semester.

Process: Faculty may nominate as many students as desired by completing a separate nomination form for each nominee. Faculty members will obtain a personal essay, not to exceed 300 words, from each student nominated and staple it to the nomination form. All nomination forms and personal essays should be delivered from faculty members to Department Chairs by **February 1, 2018**.

Chairs review all nominations from their faculty and submit only one departmental nominee for review at the College Level. **The nomination form and personal essay of the departmental nominee is due from the Chair to the Brooke Tuttle at cosescholarships@txstate.edu by 5:00 p.m. on February 5, 2018.**

The Chemistry, Biology, and Physics representatives to the College of Science and Engineering Scholarship Committee will review the three departmental nominations and make the final selection.
